

## ***Positive Relationships***

### ***Positive Behaviour***

At Gourrock Primary School we aim to provide a community in which lifelong learning takes place within an environment which motivates, challenges and develops independence united by common values and aims.

Therefore we aim to foster our values throughout every aspect of school life.

### ***Class Charter***

Each class has their class charter of the school values. This is displayed in the classroom in language appropriate to the age and stage of the children.

## ***It's Good to be Green***

"It's Good to be Green" is a programme which positively reinforces good behaviour and encourages improvement.

In each classroom there is a chart displaying each child's name with a green card. There are also amber and red cards which are used alongside positive reinforcement of the Class Charter.

Occasionally children need a reminder of the expectations in their classes. If a child needs reminding again after a warning then he/she will receive an amber card. If the child continues not to follow the class charter he/she will be requested to change the card to red. The child will then have five minutes deducted from their Golden Time.

Every day is a new day and all of the children will begin each day with a GREEN card.



### ***Golden Time***

Every Friday all children will receive 30 minutes of "Golden Time." Those children who have lost time will have this deducted on a Friday and will bring a note home to tell their parent the reason why they lost Golden Time. This will give parents the opportunity to discuss this with their child.

If a child is constantly losing "Golden Time" we will invite the parent/s in to discuss how we can work together and help your child make the right choices.

## *Rewards*

All children who follow their class/school charter will be rewarded with a range of rewards and privileges to celebrate their efforts in every way.



## *Parents as Partners*

Thank you to all of you who support your children at home. We value the partnership that we have and feel that this is crucial in encouraging the children in our school to make good decisions about their behaviour. Parents who take on a supportive role in their children's learning make a difference in improving their child's attainment and achievement.
